Dear parents and carers

As we are now only one day away from the Year 13 leavers' celebrations which are being held on Friday 1st July, I wanted to write to you all to remind you of the arrangements for the day.

Leavers' Assembly

The leavers' assembly is being held on Friday morning in school; students are asked to arrive on site for 8:40am. All students are required to go straight to their tutor rooms at this time where they will be registered for the morning and they will spend a final tutor time session with their tutors. At 9:05am, students will then meet in the school's lecture theatre for their leavers' assembly, where we will look back at their achievements over the past two years and celebrate these with them. Following on from the assembly, at approximately 10:05am, students will then make their way to the school field (weather permitting!) for a light brunch of sausage sandwiches, burgers and drinks; this will provide them with the opportunity to catch up and socialise with one another and their teachers before their prom in the evening. The event will finish by approximately 11:00am and we require all students to have left the school site by 11:30am.

Prom

The prom is being held at the Cromwell Lodge Hotel in Banbury and students will be able to enter the venue from 7:00pm onwards. Upon entry, students will have to show a form of ID to staff on the door – those who are 18 or over will be given a dark purple wristband and those under 18 will be given a pale purple wristband. These wristbands must be worn by students at all times throughout the evening in order for them to gain access to the marquee where the prom is being held, and also to be served at the bar if they are 18 or older. Students who are able to purchase alcohol must not pass this to any of their peers who are under 18 and no drinks can be brought into the venue from outside. As I have said in previous letters to you about the prom, we do expect our students who are able to consume alcohol to moderate their intake during the event and behave in a manner that is reflective of the high expectations we have for each of them. If any students do not meet these expectations or behave in a manner that could bring the school into disrepute, then they will be asked to leave the event and we will contact yourselves as their parents and carers to collect them.

Upon entering the venue, students will be served a drink and they will be able to enter the marquee and begin to spend time with their peers; the buffet will open at approximately 8:00pm, serving hot and cold food options that cater to all dietary requirements, and from 9:00pm the DJ will begin and the dancefloor will open within the marquee. The evening finishes at 11:00pm and all students must have left the venue by this time. We also wish to reiterate that the dress code is cocktail or party wear – students do not need to wear expensive prom dresses or suits to the

evening. All students are expected to have made their own suitable arrangements for their onward journeys or collection at the end of the evening as staff attending the event will also be leaving at 11:00pm.


